Since then, CDC has led construction and renovation of 187,098 square feet of retail and office space, and construction and rehabilitation of 236+ housing units in East Tampa and other lower-income communities. ### 29th Street & Lake Ave Mixed Use:

CDC of Tampa is currently in the acquisition phase of this mixed-use development and has acquired 50% of the 2.57 acres of the targeted land. Existing buildings will be demolished and redeveloped into a mixed-use development comprising residential apartment units on the second floor and office and retail space on the ground floor.



### **Manifestation Veterans Housing:**

CDC of Tampa & Manifestation Worldwide Ministries will be developing a 10-unit tiny house village for homeless veterans. This project will include project-based vouchers and wrap around services to meet the needs of veterans.

### **Scattered Site New Home Construction:**

CDC of Tampa currently has 70 scattered sites across Hillsborough (Tampa), Pinellas, and Sarasota counites that are at various stages of pre-construction and construction.
